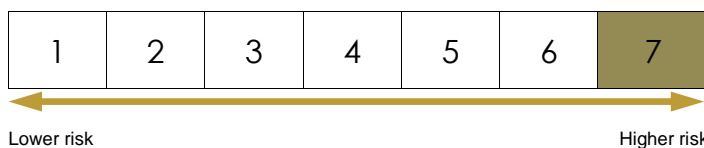

WHAT ARE THE RISKS AND WHAT COULD I GET IN RETURN?



RISK INDICATOR

The summary risk indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this product compared to other products. It shows how likely it is that the product will lose money because of movements in the markets.

INVESTMENT PERFORMANCE INFORMATION

A description of the main factors likely to affect future returns for shareholders are set out below:

Market Price - As the shares are listed on the London Stock Exchange, their prices are affected by supply and demand. This means that share prices may be higher or lower than the Net Asset Value (NAV) of the fund. The NAV is the value per share of all the assets owned by the investment trust.

What could affect my return positively?

- Strong demand for the shares which can cause the price of the shares to rise
- Good underlying performance in or a rise in the value of the assets held by the fund
- if the price of the Ordinary Shares is greater than the Exercise Price of the Subscription Shares plus the cost of purchase

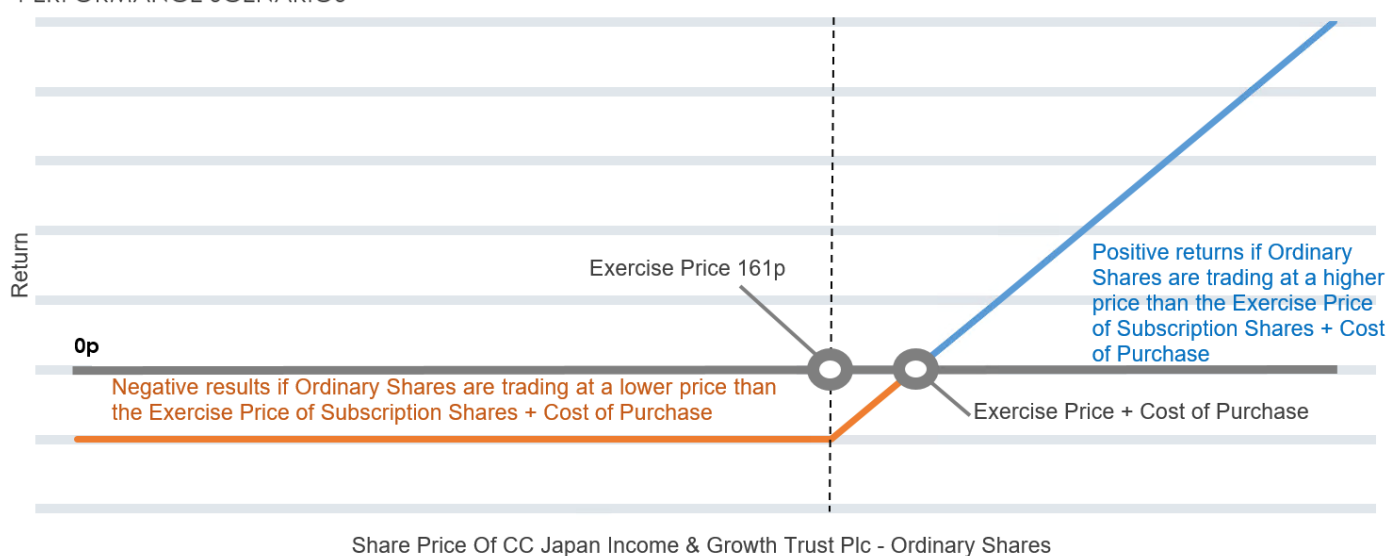
What could affect my return negatively?

- Lack of demand for the shares which may create share price falls
- Poor performance or a fall in value of the assets held by the fund
- if the price of the Ordinary Shares is less than the Exercise Price of the Subscription Shares plus the cost of purchase

What happens where shares are sold under severely adverse market conditions?

If there is a lack of demand for the shares, it may not be possible to sell shares quickly or easily and the price may be negatively impacted. However, shareholders cannot lose more than the initial price paid for the shares.
